

Shepherds Down School

Primary School Sports Funding 2019/20



In this academic year 19/20 Shepherds Down School received £17,500 Sports Premium Funding.

This grant has been awarded to primary schools to enhance the opportunity for pupils to engage in physical activities.

This academic year we plan to spend this funding to:

Replace and Improve sports/exercise equipment – we will spend £5000 on replacing equipment, such as trampettes, resources which enable active playtimes, balls and exercise equipment

Provide Coaching and additional sports activities - we will spend £12,500 on coaching and additional activities, such as:

- Support for Swimming - increased access beyond statutory provision – pool hire and coach
- Planet Education - Multi skills sessions 1 day/week
- Horseriding – Therapy, Interaction and mobility
- After School Multiskills Club
(The club costs £100 to staff each session. We charge £3 per child for each session. We have a maximum of 20 children attend. Over the year we have 30 sessions arranged. Cost to school = £1200, if all places taken up)

All pupils across the school will benefit at some stage from the enhanced input.
